

# Information for Campers

**A warm welcome from Wiston Lodge to all Campers  
Please read these guidelines to help you to enjoy your stay here.**

- **Arrival.** Please follow signs and **report to Reception** in the Main Lodge (09:00 – 17:00). If arriving after office hours, please pitch your tent/s and report to reception the following morning.
- **Parking.** Head north out of the back car park, up the track. Then turn left after the detached house which is signposted 'Cabins' down onto the campfield. Face your car down the hill to enable easy exit on wet ground. The exit is downhill at the left corner of the field.
- **Privacy.** Please respect the privacy of other campers, the cabins and the private house nearby when pitching your tent and **leave no trace** from pitching, cooking, litter etc.
- **Toilet block** is situated behind the cottage. **Dishwashing** sink is at the East side of the building next to the track.
- **Drinking water** is available from this sink, from the tap at the bottom of the campfield and from a new hose attachment below the cottage.
- **Showers** can be taken in the main Lodge building, open from 8 am – 10 pm, and are situated inside the back door of the Lodge (opposite the stores).
- **Fire Safety.** A Fire equipment trolley is located by the cabins. Please familiarise your entire group with its location and do not use any items for any other purpose. Do not put yourself at risk by fighting a fire unless you deem it safe to do so. There is a Fire Warden on site and an emergency Duty Manager on call at all times. The fire assembly point is on the front lawn by the Main Lodge.
- **First Aid** facilities are available at the Lodge, should you require assistance. There will be an on call Duty Manager available for emergencies throughout your stay on **01899 850693**.
- **Noise.** We ask you to observe a **noise curfew from 11pm to 8am**
- **Alcohol.** Alcohol can be consumed on site **by arrangement**. Sensible, monitored consumption in designated areas only, taking into account other groups on site and their needs. At times the estate is a no alcohol zone so **please check** on booking to avoid disappointment.
- **Fires.** Please only light fires in designated areas, marked on the map. Fire sites must be pre-booked. You can bring your own wood or pre-order a load (£20 per night or £30 for the weekend) from the office in advance of arrival. Please do not gather wood from the surrounding woodland or the materials compound.

- **Swimming** is *strictly prohibited* in the Canoe Pond; please take responsibility for your group at all times. Instructors can be booked in advance through the office so you can enjoy the activities on site.
- **Grounds.** Please walk in the grounds (52 acres) with respect and do not disturb other groups working, wildlife or pick any plants or fungi.
- **Built Activity Structures.** Please stay off all structures unless under supervision of a Wiston Lodge Instructor. Activity sessions can be arranged for groups through Reception.
- **Path of the Little People.** If this fantastic new resource is not in use by a group, we invite you to walk through and explore this area. However we politely request that you do not interact with the activity structures without a Wiston Lodge instructor. For more information, see the office or the signs at each entrance gate to the Path of the Little People.
- **Rubbish Bins** are located on the camp field and in the main Car Park. We encourage you to respect the environment and to reuse and recycle wherever possible. Please take with you any items for recycling, bottles, paper, tins and plastics as we have limited amenities.
- **Payment:** your total fee will be confirmed by the office **prior** to the date of your arrival, after which numbers can go up but not down. You may pay by BACS prior to your visit or by cash / cheque on arrival. Please note that in the event of cancellation less than 28 days prior to your stay, full payment is required.
- **Further information.** Please contact Reception or a member of Wiston Lodge Staff.
- **Emergencies.** Please contact Reception during working hours. After working hours please contact the Duty Manager on call: **01899 850693**.
