

To ensure everyone stays safe and well during activities sessions, we have implemented the following:

1. Visitors will be asked to **remain at least 2 metres** from others as much as possible – with the exception of under 12s who do not need to social distance from one another.
2. Activity groups are limited to a **maximum of 8 people** (including any leaders/parents not taking part)
3. All activities will take place outdoors. However, for some activities it may be necessary for participants to wear **face coverings** if there is a chance that 2 metre distancing may be broken. Face coverings should always be worn when inside – this includes toilets.
4. Where possible, participants will be talked through putting on **safety equipment**, if our instructors need to assist they will be fully equipped with the necessary personal protective equipment to do so.
5. Some activities may have new **age restrictions** to maintain safety in certain activities where the instructors cannot assist hands-on (e.g. archery).
6. All of our activity safety equipment (helmets, buoyancy aids, harnesses) as well as any borrowed equipment (wellies, jackets etc.) go through a 24 hour quarantine in a room with an ozone generator to thoroughly **sanitise between groups**.

7. If there are multiple groups on site at the same time, they will be **kept separate throughout**, this includes not taking part in the same activities, not using the same equipment and using different toilets.
